Taking the Advanced Placement (AP) exams is an important part of all AP courses. Mount Si High School desires that all students take AP exams for the AP classes they have taken. Scoring well on an AP exam can often earn students college credit, which saves the cost of tuition.

Online registration for AP Exams

- **Registration Opens:** Monday, Jan. 28th at 6:00 AM

- **Early Registration Closes:** Friday, March 8th at 11:59 PM (Late fees are assigned after this date, see AP Exam Costs)
- **Registration Closes:** Friday, March 22nd at 11:59 PM
- **How to Register:**
 - 1) Sign into Total Registration using the link found above and on the MSHS website.
 - 2) Sign up for each AP Exam (refer to AP Exam schedule)
 - 3) Sign up for a pre-id session (refer to AP pre-id schedule)
 - 4) Pay for all AP Exams
 - 5) To complete registration, print the PDF confirmation page

Exam Conflict

- Conflicts with the assigned AP exam schedule may occur.
- Before deciding to test or not test contact Mr. Rick Dempsey to develop an alternative.

AP Exam Costs

- **Fee Per AP Exam:** \$104.00 (\$15 is non-refundable if you cancel an Exam)
- **Registration Fee after Friday, March 8th at 11:59 PM:** \$20 late fee per exam
- **Late Registration Fee after Friday, March 22nd at 12:01 AM:** \$75 late fee per exam

Registrations that have not been paid before Wednesday, March 27, 2019 at 11:59 PM will be cancelled and exams will not be ordered.

Requesting Financial Assistance

- During registration, request a fee waiver. The waiver is processed to determine if a waiver is available. Final payment will occur after waiver is applied.
- Fee waivers are provided for all students who are currently on the free/reduced lunch program.
